


Memory Lane... Coolangatta in the 50's 60's & 80's

Quick fixes to make around The home



Stuck Sliding Windows Grease the skids using a little silicone spray lubricant Spray it onto a rag, then wipe along the tracks.

Hard-To-Remove Lightbulb

Press the centre of a 30cm strip of duct tape onto the middle of the bulb. Fold each loose end in half so it sticks onto itself. Give it an anti-clockwise twist to loosen the bulb.

Slamming Door

Soften the slam of a door by fixing a few pieces of peel-and-stick foam weather stripping around the doorstop. Or get a wide rubber band and wrap it around the doorknobs on both sides, stretching it across the edge of the door.

Flattened Down Cushions

Put them outside in the sun for a few hours, flipping them halfway through. (Be careful leaving them out too long as it may fade the fabric.) The sun


